

CKRZ Blues Talent Search 2022

Submission Criteria

The CKRZ Blues Talent Search are open to Indigenous ensembles, solo artists, duos, or groups from across Southern Ontario

To be eligible for the CKRZ Blues Talent Search, at least 50 percent of group members and/or artistic driving force and ownership behind the brand must identify as Indigenous. Proof of ancestry may be required (if new to the Indigenous music industry). Such proof may include a status card, Metis card or a letter of confirmation from a community leader/elder. Solo Artists may also be asked to confirm their Indigenous status. The CKRZ Blues Talent Search reserve the right to make decisions on discretionary issues that may arise.

Submission Process

Artists must submit 3 songs with video (preferably in MP4 format)

Songs may be submitted via email to socialmedia@ckrzfm.com or dropped off by USB to the CKRZ Studios at 1721 Chiefswood Road

All submissions must be able to attend the CKRZ Blues Talent Search on Thursday August 4, 2022 and the winner of the CKRZ Blues Talent Search must be able to attend the Tim Hortons Southside Shuffle on Saturday September 10, 2022

Artists must also submit a biography, band picture for posters, and their social media accounts for promotional purposes

Deadline for submissions: Friday July 8, 2022

Only chosen submissions will be contacted

1ST Place - \$1000 plus an opening spot on the CKRZ Stage at the Tim Hortons Southside Shuffle the 24th Annual Port Credit Blues and Jazz Festival

2nd Place - \$500
